The proposed revisions strengthen ACCJC's *Policy on Transfer of Credit* in conformity with the stated regulations. Further, ACCJC's guides and templates are being revised to ensure that colleges address these policy requirements in their institutional self-evaluations and that peer review teams monitor compliance. ACCJC communicated this impending change in a letter to all institutions in fall 2022, as well as notified the field in its fall 2022 newsletter issue of *ACCJC Connect*.
