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3. Promise Program

Hartnell enrollment data shows a 14% increase from local high schools 37% increase in students who enrolled **-firth**e

North Monterey County HS showed the highest increase in enrollment, from 10 full time in to 51 full time More than a 10% improvement over the prior three years

The increase in enrollment of fullme students is particularly important because fullme students complete a certificate, a degree or transfer to a university at a higher rate than tipate students.

An Analysis of Variance (ANOVA) was conducted to compare the difference in course success rates between full Salinas Valley Promise students and tighte, first time in college students (not in SVP). The results of an ANOVA found that Fulltime Salinas Valley Promise participants were more likely to succeed.
