Background:

Title 5 provides the State Chancellor's Office authority to hold a district's enrollment FTES stable at a level reported prior to the occurrence of the emergency.

Requirements:

Districts must complete an application that shows:

1. Emergency Conditions Recovery Plan, adopted and approved by the local Board of Trustees and
2. Certification confirming that the District meets specific eligibility requirements.

State Approval and Next Steps:

1. Application Approved on October 14 2022
2. Mid Year Report to Board Submitted to State Chancellor's Office by Feb. 28, 2023

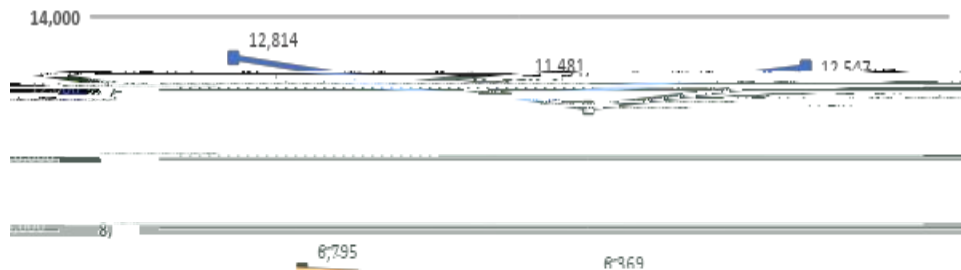

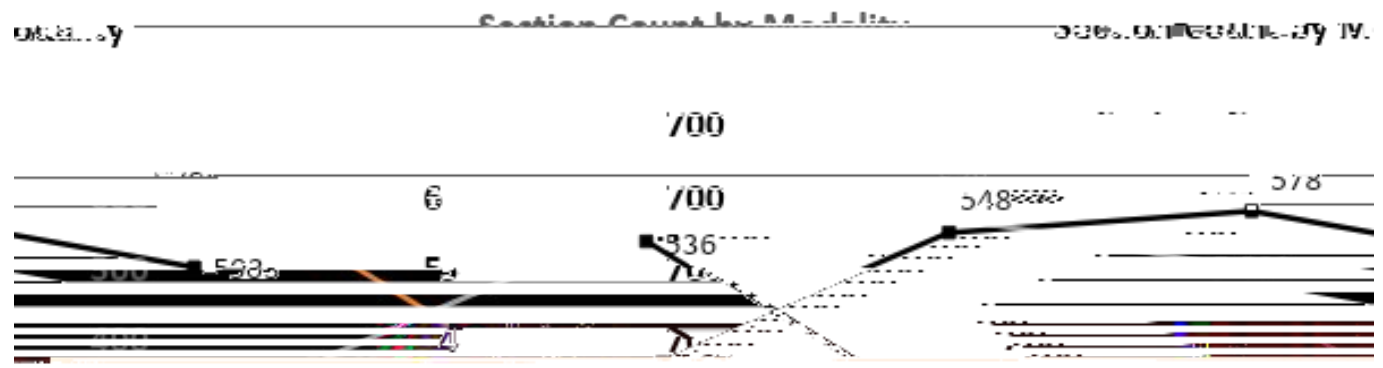




Enrollment Comparison by Age Group: Fall 20, Fall 21, Fall 22
