

CONDITIONS OF AWARDS

In order to receive financial aid at Hartnell Community College (HCC), I must comply with the following terms:

- 1. Comply with the Federal Pell Grant regulations, which prohibit a student from receiving Federal Pell Grant from more than one institution at the same time.
- 2. Enroll at HCC in a program leading toward a certificate, degree, or be in a program that is acceptable for transfer (must not have received an AA/AS Degree). The certificate program should be at least 16 semester units long.
- 3. Enroll in at least Less than Half time status per semester at HCC in order to receive a Federal Pell Grant (if eligible) and in at least six (6) units per semester to qualify for Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (SEOG), and at least (9) units per semester to qualify for Federal Work Study, and at least (6) units per semester for CAL Grants.
- 4. Award amounts on my Award Letter (except for CA Promise Grant (formerly BOGW) **may be reduced** based on my enrollment status. In some instances I may become **ineligible** for the grant(s) if I do not maintain full-time status (12 units).
- 5. My eligibility for financial aid depends on my maintaining **Satisfactory Academic Progress** according to the standards of Hartnell Community College financial aid.
