KNOWLEDGE OF:

Use basic methods, materials, and equipment used in custodial work;

Good work habits;

Appropriate safety precautions and procedures;

Basic tools used in the routine maintenance of campus buildings and facilities.

ABILITY TO:

Learn schedules, procedures, and the use of tools and equipment used in custodial work;

Work without immediate supervision;

Learn to use cleaning materials, disinfectants, and equipment used in custodial work;

Understand and carry out oral and written instructions;

Establish and maintain effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Any combination of training, education, and experience which demonstrates possession of the knowledge and abilities stated above and the ability to perform the duties of the position. A typical qualifying entrance background is entry-level experience performing routine janitorial, custodial, or cleaning work demanding heavy physical stamina and promptness.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORKING CONDITIONS

LIGHT WORK:

Positions in this class perform work which involves the frequent lifting, pushing, and/or pulling of objects which may approximate 50 pounds and may occasionally weigh up to 100 pounds.

MOBILITY:

Positions in this class require mobility of arms to reach and dexterity of hands to grasp and manipulate small objects;

Some positions in this class require the mobility to stand, stoop, reach, and bend.

OTHER CONDITIONS:

Most incumbents in this class are required to work evening shifts.
