

Institution-Set Standards for 2014-15

Approved by Board of Trustees

April 7, 2015

1. Use four measures (course completions, course retention, certificates, degrees)
2. Apply to each measure the method of taking the mean of the immediate five previous years and reducing it by five percent of the mean
3. Publish the results of the procedure delineated in and 2 above as the four institution-set standards for the current year.

when the general enrollment period ends (first census date). Completions are calculated based on the fall semester only.

2. Course Retention: Of all credit enrollments, the rate at which students completed courses and did not drop or withdraw from them.
3. Certificates: Students who received one or more certificates in the specified year, with each student counted once. For purposes of definition, certificates include those certificate programs which qualify for financial aid, principally those which lead to gainful employment.
4. Degrees: Students who received one or more degrees in the specified year, with each student counted once.
