Board Policies and Administrative Procedures

The CPC took action to approve the following board policies and administrative procedures. The BP/APs will move forward to the Governing Board for information and/or consideration and approval:

BP 4021, Establishing, Revitalizing, or Discontinuing Academic Programs

The CPC reviewed and discussed the following

reviews and the total is estimated at \$5.5 million. The CPC agreed to form an ad hoc committee to prioritize the requests and bring back a recommendation; similar to the process used last year to prioritize resource requests for 2014-15. Members were identified and the committee will meet several times over the next few weeks and bring their recommendations to the CPC meeting scheduled in December.

Continuous Improvement Process for Non-Instructional Programs

The CPC received the Continuous Improvement Process for Non-Instructional Programs, a process parallel to BP/AP 4021 Establishing, Revitalizing, or Discontinuing Academic Programs. De Lofman, Dean of Institutional Planning and Effectiveness summarized key differences and noted that this completes 27 out of 30 continuous improvement processes.

First Annual Assessment of Long Term Plans

The first annual assessment of the Technology Master Plan is complete and the CPC reviewed the document. Each of the college's long term plans will undergo an annual assessment to determine if plan activities are completed, desired outcomes are produced, and the overall long term plan is on track.
