1. Institutional Outcomes

Degree and Certificate Awards

Dr. Lewallen reported a 2.6% increase in student enrollment and a 96.7% increase in degrees and certificates awarded in academic year 2015-16 as compared to 2011-12. The increase and success is contributed to a collection of practices, procedures, and systems working together.

UC and CSU Transfer Outcomes

Dr. Lewallen reported a 29% increase in transfers, with a 2.6% increase in student enrollment in academic year 2015-16 as compared to 2011-12.

Fall 2016 UC Transfer Outcomes

Dr. Lewallen shared the data on University of California (UC) Transfer Outcomes for fall 2016 and was proud to report that Hartnell experienced the largest number of UC transfers (80) in its history. The increase represents a 35.6% increase over the previous year. Of these 80, 11 transferred to UC Berkeley, ten of whom are Hispanic/Latino students
